

# SOUTHERN CROSS GRAMMAR INDIGENOUS STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Indigenous Student Scholarships provide opportunities to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students to attend Southern Cross Grammar at a significant discount. The scholarships are part of the School's plan to help improve education outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students at the secondary schooling level.

Where vacancies occur, up to five scholarships are available to be awarded annually across Years 7 - 12.

#### Who can apply?

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students enrolling in Years 7 to 12 seeking a high performing and academic experience.

#### How do the scholarships work?

Successful applicants receive up to 80% off tuition and associated costs including uniform, books and the compulsory camps program.

Scholarships will be awarded on merit against the selection criteria outlined in the guidelines. Priority is given to students who are local, might otherwise be unable to afford this opportunity and have not previously received an Indigenous Scholarship.
