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### School Photo Day Friday 3 May

A reminder that our 2019 School Photos will be taken in the Junior School Learning Hub on Friday 3 May and we hope this reminder may assist you in helping your son/daughter get ready for their 2019 School Photos.



#### **Important Reminders:**

- Students must be appropriately dressed in their formal winter uniform (\*In photos Blazers will be worn, but no jumpers in Year 3-12. Years F-2 will wear jumpers/vests as their outer-garment\*)
- Each student's Photo Order envelope will be handed to the photographers on the day
- Personal presentation (hair, accessories, etc.) should be prepared prior to the day – any student that does not adhere to School policies may be excluded from photographs
- Any student with a PE practical class on the day will be required to bring their PE uniform to change in to once photos are completed
- A schedule for the day's proceedings will be communicated to students via the Student Bulletin which they will need to follow (this will occur earlier in the week of photos)
- Any envelopes not submitted on this day to place orders will be the responsibility of families to pursue directly with the photographic company (online or via phone)

#### Males

## Returns process for Photo envelopes:

If you wish to order photos, place the order online (payment via credit card) or by place the correct cash in the envelope provided. \*Regardless of the order method, please note: Envelopes must be returned to students' Homeroom teacher by Tuesday 30 April 2019\*

Each student is required to submit a Photo Order Envelope to the photographers at the time of photos being taken, regardless of whether photos are being purchased or not.

#### Sibling Photos:

As a component of the day, sibling photos will be available, however it is imperative that your children understand they must arrive at the Junior School Hub at the appropriate time. Sibling photos will be taken immediately following Homeroom on this day. Siblings should report to the JS LRC to have these photos taken, with the Sibling Photo envelope in hand [eldest sibling to manage please]

## Term 2 Student Progress Interviews

A gentle reminder to all families that we look forward to meeting with parents and students in Week 3 of Term 2 for our customary Student Progress Interviews. Please note the dates and times below so as to be available to meet with your child's teachers and gain insight into your child's learning, progress and achievement. Interviews provide opportunity for three-way conversation, an occasion for student reflection and for students, parents and teachers to work together to ensure our students are supported to achieve the best possible learning and personal development outcomes. All students are encouraged to attend interviews with their parents. Students attending the interviews are expected to be in full school uniform.

Interviews will be conducted with Homeroom teachers from F – Y6, with Subject teachers from Y7 – Y12 and in the JS, MS and SS buildings;

- from 3:30pm 8:30pm on Monday 6 May
- from 8:30am 8:00pm on Wednesday 8 May 2019
