The School will undertake a comprehensive recruitment process for the Head of Middle School (5-9) position and while this is undertaken, Mr David Wildsmith will serve as the Acting Head of Middle School (5-9) from the commencement of Term 3 2019.

Mrs Julie Baud Deputy Principal Head of Teaching and Learning (F – 12)

Tomorrow morning the majority of our Year 11 and 12 students will complete a practice General Achievement Test (GAT) to help prepare them for the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) GAT scheduled for Wednesday 12 June. While the GAT results do not directly contribute to a student's ATAR, the results can play a very important role in determining the outcome of the final assessments. This practice exam is therefore an important opportunity for students to gain some insight into the type of questions they will need to answer.

The mid-year exam timetables for both Middle School and Years 10 and 11 are to be published in next week's Newsletter. As discussed with the students, exams for the 3/4 subjects will now take place on Thursday 11 July, Friday 12 July and Monday 15 July.

Students are currently being briefed about the exam week and their input is being sought over a number of issues so the schedule will be finalised very soon. I thank our VCE Coordinator, Ms Megan Unthank, for her work in this area. With the continued growth in the Senior School, it has become a more complex task to schedule all of these exams appropriately.

Semester 2 will commence in Week 9 (Monday 17 June) of this term, immediately after the conclusion of the exam week, so Year 11 and 12 subjects will commence Units 2 and 4. I remind families of our Senior School Attendance Policy (Page 18 of the 2019 Policy Handbook) that indicates students missing more than 20% of classes without the approval of the school may receive an "N" for that unit.' So despite being the end of term, attendance over these last two weeks will be important.
