- school report (Semester 2, 2021)
- NAPLAN results
- AMEB results and;
- any supporting documentation.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

- Academic Examination: Candidates for the 2023 Music Scholarship are required to register for, and sit, the Edutest Academic Scholarship Examination on Saturday 19 February 2022. Registrations for the Examination close at 4:00pm on Friday 25 February 2022. To register, please click <u>here</u>.
- Audition: We require Music Scholarship Candidates to audition before our Selection Panel on-site in the week commencing Monday 14 March 2022 (following the Labour Day public holiday). We will contact families beforehand with a date and time for their child's audition.
- Interview with the Principal: We invite candidates to an interview with our Principal, Mr Matt Dodd. The invitation is based on a candidate's proficiency in the Edutest Academic Scholarship Examination, their audition performance, and evidence of a minimum standard of AMEB Grade 4 in their chosen instrument.

The Music Scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Principal.


