- a. Private Instrumental Music Tuition charges will be included on your Tuition Invoice and payable in advance of lessons commencing.
- b. Private Instrumental Music Tuition charges are listed on the School's website (https://www.scg.vic.edu.au/fees/)
- c. Lessons may be delayed where fees (including Tuition and/or Music charges) are in arrears. Extended delay in settling an invoice may influence the ability to deliver a full semester program.

2. Semester Duration

- a. An Instrumental semester consists of sixteen (16) lessons per semester. Semester 1 comprises Terms 1 and 2, Semester 2 comprises Terms 3 and 4.
- b. Additional lessons are available by applying to the Head of Music via music@scg.vic.edu.au. Additional lessons will be charged at the prorata rate of the charges refer to in 1.a. The Head of Music and tutor provide to commencement.

3. Lesson Cancellation

- a. Students will be issued with their lesson timetable in Week 1 of each term.
- b. Students who are absent from school due to illness must advise the Music Department by 8.30am that day via music@scg.vic.edu.au noting that the student will not be attending their scheduled music lesson.
- c. Students who are unable to attend a lesson due to a planned absence must inform the Head of Music, via music@scg.vic.edu.au, at least 24 hours prior to the lesson. Examples of a planned absence include but are not limited to, scheduled appointments or family holidays.
- d. Lessons cancelled with the required notice as per items 3.b or 3.c will be rescheduled where possible.
- e. In the event that a lesson has not been rescheduled prior to the end of the semester due to school events or tutor absence, please contact the Head of Music via music@scg.vic.edu.au.

4. Withdrawal from Program

- a. Enrolment in the Private Instrumental Tuition Program is for the full semester. Enrolment will roll over to the next semester (including into the next school year) unless notification is made to the Head of Music via music@scg.vic.edu.au
- b. Students who withdraw from the program mid-semester will not have their fees for that semester refunded.

5. Instrument Hire and External Examinations

- a. Hiring and purchase of instruments is to be organised externally by the parent/caregiver. Parents or students may consult tutors for advice on instrumental hire and purchase. Payment, collection and care of these instruments are the responsibility of the parent/caregiver.
