

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Candidates applying for the 2024 Music Scholarship must be entering Year 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 in 2024.

### **HOW TO APPLY**

To apply for the Music Scholarship, candidates must complete the scholarship application form and submit the application to the school office by 4:00pm on Friday 24 February 2023. Your application must include your most recent:

- school reports (Semester 1 & 2, 2022)
- NAPLAN results
- AMEB results and;
- any supporting documentation.

#### THE SELECTION PROCESS

- Academic Examination: Candidates for the 2024 Music Scholarship are required to register for, and sit, the Edutest Academic Scholarship Examination on Saturday 18 February 2023. Registrations for the Examination close at 4:00pm on Friday 10 February 2023.
- Audition: We require Music Scholarship Candidates to audition before our Selection Panel on-site
  in the week commencing Monday 13 March 2023 (following the Labour Day public holiday). We will
  contact families beforehand with a date and time for their child's audition.
- Interview with the Principal: We invite selected candidates to an interview with our Principal,
  Mr Matt Dodd. The invitation is based on a candidate's proficiency in the Edutest Academic
  Scholarship Examination, their audition performance, and evidence of a minimum standard of AMEB
  Grade 4 in their chosen instrument.

The Music Scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Principal.
