

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates applying for the 2024 Music Scholarship must be entering Year 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 in 2024.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply for the Music Scholarship, candidates must complete the scholarship application form and submit the application to the school office by 4:00pm on Friday 24 February 2023. Your application must include your most recent:

- school reports (Semester 1 & 2, 2022)
- NAPLAN results
- AMEB results and;
- any supporting documentation.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

- **Academic Examination:** Candidates for the 2024 Music Scholarship are required to register for, and sit, the Edutest Academic Scholarship Examination on Saturday 18 February 2023. Registrations for the Examination close at 4:00pm on Friday 10 February 2023.
- **Audition:** We require Music Scholarship Candidates to audition before our Selection Panel on-site in the week commencing Monday 13 March 2023 (following the Labour Day public holiday). We will contact families beforehand with a date and time for their child's audition.
- **Interview with the Principal:** We invite selected candidates to an interview with our Principal, Mr Matt Dodd. The invitation is based on a candidate's proficiency in the Edutest Academic Scholarship Examination, their audition performance, and evidence of a minimum standard of AMEB Grade 4 in their chosen instrument.

The Music Scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Principal.
