HOW TO APPLY

To apply for the Indigenous Scholarship, please complete the scholarship application form and submit the application to the school office by 4:00pm Friday 16 February 2024. Applications must include the candidate's most recent:

- school report (Semester 1 & 2, 2023)
- NAPLAN results
- · Confirmation/Evidence of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- · Birth Certificate of Applicant
- Documentation in support of student achievements

Scholarships will be awarded on merit against the selection criteria outlined in the guidelines. Priority is given to students who are local, might otherwise be unable to afford this opportunity and have not previously received an Indigenous Scholarship.
